BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION

Robert Winer, M.D. is a board-certified neurologist, psychoanalyst, and psychopharmacologist in practice since 1983 after completing his neurology residency at the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Winer also completed a fellowship in psychopharmacology at University of Pennsylvania where he worked on the National Institute of Mental Health's Collaborative Program on the psycho-biology of depression and at the Lithium Clinic of the Affective Diseases Research Unit. Dr. Winer has also been an investigator in drug trials for medications used in dementia, headache, and epilepsy. His areas of clinical expertise are neurology, psychopharmacology, neuropsychiatry, and psychoanalysis.

Dr. Winer trained in Jungian psychology / psychoanalysis in both the United States and at the *Forschungs und Ausbildungszentrum fur Tiefenpsychologie* in Zurich, Switzerland. In January, 2007, he completed the Swiss equivalent of a master's degree in Analytical Psychology and also became an Associate Psychoanalyst under the National Association for the Advancement of Psychoanalysis, New York, NY. Dr. Winer is the President of the C.G. Jung Center of Philadelphia, an organization that for nearly forty years has provided quality psychological education to the public.

Dr. Winer is the author of two books and more than fifty articles on national and international political affairs, religion, spirituality. He is a seminar speaker in the fields of neurology and psychiatry. In 2001, he established a Visiting Professorship in Neurology and Psychiatry and an elective program for medical students and residents at the Addis Ababa University School of Medicine, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.
