I-76 FROM WALT WHITMAN BRIDGE

Go on west I-76. Get off at Passyunk Avenue exit. Turn right at light onto Passyunk. Stay on Passyunk. After 63rd Street, its name changes to Essington Ave. (Also called the Auto Mall because of all the car dealerships there). Turn right onto 70th street. Left on Lindbergh Blvd. At 2nd traffic light, after the Staples, bear right onto Island Ave access road (far right lane). Continue past the Library and turn right into the parking lot with two medical buildings. Mercy Eastwick Medical Arts Building is the low rise building.

I-95 (Traveling South from New York)

Continue past Philadelphia exits (Society Hill, Columbus Ave.) Exit 291 / Bartram Ave. (If you are at the Philadelphia Airport exit, you've gone too far). Follow Bartrum Avenue. Turn right onto Island Ave. Stay in the right lane. The road goes up an incline. On the way down look for a break in the concrete to get at the access road on the far right (near Wilson Safe Company / McDonalds). Stay on the Island Avenue access road. Go past the light (Lindbergh Ave.). Continue past the Library and turn right into the parking lot with two medical buildings. Mercy Eastwick Medical Arts Building is the low rise building.

I-95 (Traveling North from Baltimore)

Continue past the Philadelphia Airport. Exit Island Ave. Right turn onto Island Ave. Stay in the right lane. The road goes up an incline. On the way down look for a break in the concrete to get at the access road on the far right (near Wilson Safe Company / McDonalds). Stay on the Island Avenue access road. Go past the light (Lindbergh Ave.). Continue past the Library and turn right into the parking lot with two medical buildings. Mercy Eastwick Medical Arts Building is the low rise building.

From West Philadelphia (Haveford Ave. and 63rd Street).

Go on 63rd Street toward Market Street. Stay on 63rd (curves to the right past Christian / Ellsworth Streets). At Baltimore Ave. traffic light, veer right onto 58th Street (stay in right lane). Within a few hundred feet, right turn onto Cobbs Creek Parkway. Stay on this past Church Lane / Woodland Ave where the name changes to Island Avenue. The road will divide into four lane. Get into the far left lane. At Lindbergh Blvd., make a sharp left U-turn into the far right access road of Island Ave. Continue past the Library and turn right into the parking lot with two medical buildings. Mercy Eastwick Medical Arts Building is the low rise building.
