

Neuropsychological Assessment

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Unlike, most neuropsychological testing performed by psychologists, Dr. Winer performs the assessment from the neurological standpoint. As a board-certified neurologist he brings a different level of expertise to the testing situation than the psychologist or neuropsychologist.

In addition, Dr. Winer is a fellowship-trained psychopharmacologist providing him with an expertise not traditionally found either in assessments by a psychiatrist or psychologist. Finally, being a psychoanalyst trained in Switzerland at the *Forschungs und Ausbildungszentrum für Tiefenpsychologie* he brings a distinctly different and unique perspective to bear in conditions demanding the highest level of neurologic and psychological competency.

Elements

1. The neuropsychological testing battery.
2. Clinical neurological and psychological examinations and impression.
3. Level of functioning (ADL, executive, etc.)
4. Diagnosis including, if possible, localization of abnormalities on testing to various lobes or parts of the brain.
6. Prognosis
7. Treatment recommendations

(At times, testing may be performed for pre-treatment assessment (chemotherapy, radiation therapy, or pre-cardiac bypass).
